

Measure 4.3 Project – ‘Increasing Accessibility and Promoting Agricultural Activity – Gharb’

‘Support for investments in infrastructure related to development, modernization or adaptation of agriculture and forestry’

In 2018, the I-Gharb Local Council managed to obtain funding under Measure 4.3 which project falls under the Rural Funding Program for Malta 2014-2020 to resurface Trux Street between San Dimitri Chapel and lower part of Trux Street and Wied tal-Knisja Street. These roads were in a bad state of repair, with gravel and stones sticking out. Dust and soil on the surface became slippery mud when it rained. Through weather elements and daily use they had become eroded and causing difficulties since they were the only access points for several agricultural holdings in Gharb. Through these funds the Council managed to give a new surface to the streets as well as construct of a water gutter in ‘Wied tal-Knisja’ and resurfacing the road which connects Trux Street to San Dimitri Chapel. These were cleaned from debris and weeds and later resurfacing. Through this project the farmers will gain more accessibility to these areas.
